Let's Simplify – Top Cyber Threats



IT Security Activities Underway in Wespath

- Upgrading our laptops, desktops and mobile phones
- Moving to zero trust security we trust no one, even in our own building
- Multi-factor authentication everywhere
- Very complex passwords 16 characters, upper/ lower case, number and special characters
- Guest WiFi password is complex and changes monthly
- Upgrading our Data Loss Prevention (DLP) tools



Actions You Can Take

- 1. Create a cadence of **regular system updates** (phones, laptops, desktops, etc.)
- 2. Use multi-factor authentication everywhere
- Implement very complex passwords –
 16 characters, upper/lower case, numbers and special characters
- Have a complex guest WiFi password and change it monthly
- 5. Ensure complex WiFi passwords and hide SSIDs
- 6. Educate, educate your staff about phishing
- 7. Protect yourself
