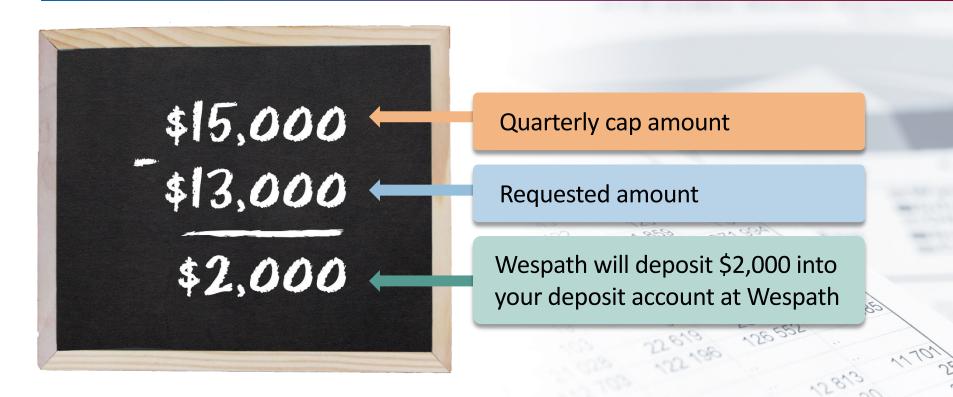

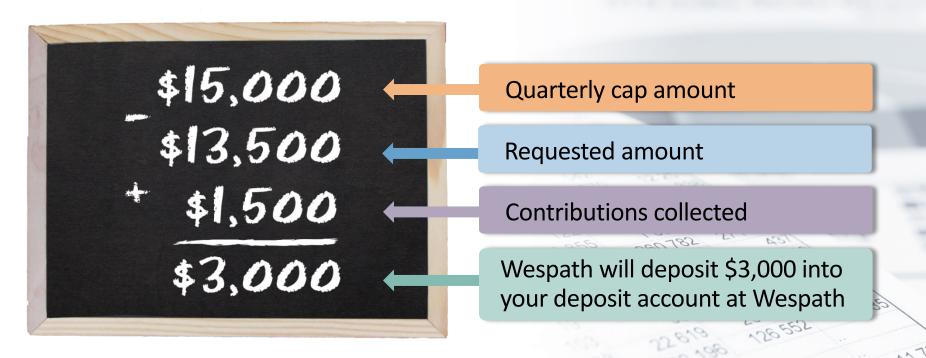
Deposit Accounts

- The deposit accounts were set up to help with investing the pension plan
- The accounts can be funded in three ways:
 - 1. Difference between quarterly cap amount and the requested amount, based on the quarterly list
 - 2. Reduce the requested amount by the amount of contributions collected by the plan
 - 3. The plan can send an incoming wire to Wespath

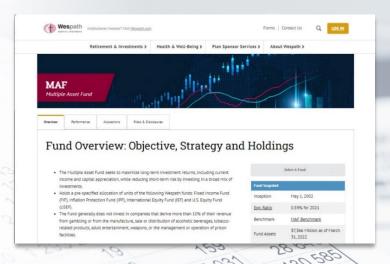

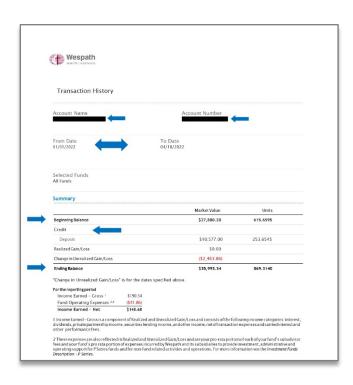


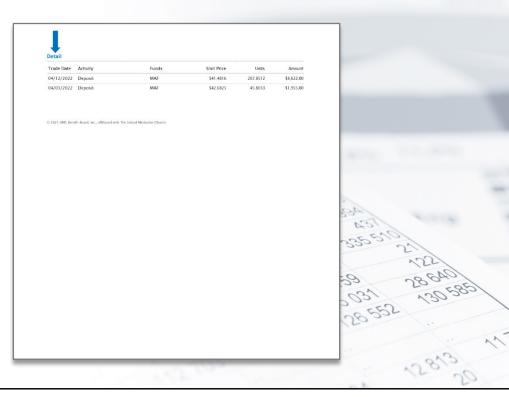
Investment Fund(s)

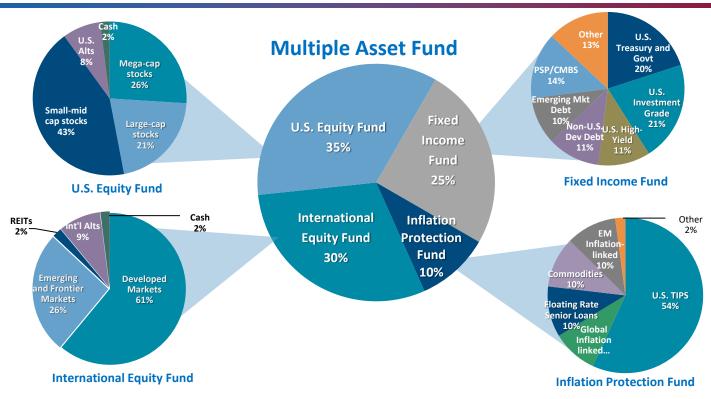

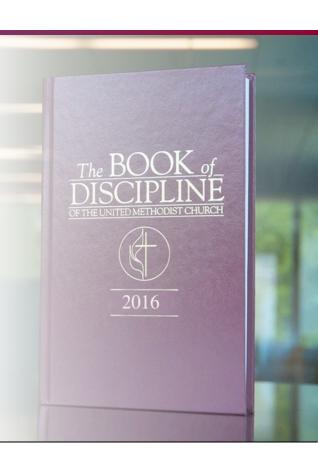
