



2019 Federal

Law Changes



2019 Federal Regulatory Changes

- Final Rule (June 2019) for Individual Coverage HRAs (ICHRAs) does not affect HealthFlex plan sponsors
- Might be an option for conferences that ended sponsorship of a health plan
- Effective January 1, 2020
- Idea: Allow an HRA to pay for individual health coverage
- Some technical requirements

New HRA Rule

Technical Requirements

- Cannot offer group health plan and new ICHRA to the same class of employees (full-time, part-time, etc.)
- Same terms (except for age and family size)
- Employee must attest to enrollment in individual coverage
- Employee has opt-out rights
- Notice to employees required

Bills Introduced in Congress

June 2019:

Senators Alexander and Murray introduce: "Lower Health Care Costs Act" (S. 1895)

Title III:	Improving Transparency	
Title IV:	Improving Public Health	
Title V:	Improving Exchange of Health InformationRequest for input	



Details of S. 1895

Group health plan shall:

- Provide an estimate of the amount the participant would owe for a specific service (Section 309)
- Make available claims and payment information for each participant for the past 5 years in a format that is "easy to understand" (Section 501)


