




COVID-19 and 2020 Health Claims

National: Deferred Health Care by Region




National: Drop in 2020 Health Care Utilization





HealthFlex: Fewer Preventive Screenings



Counts based on screenings between Jan-Aug of each year; Screenings for 2020 are below prior year counts by: 23% (Breast CA), 26% (Cervical CA), 34% (Colon CA).

HealthFlex: Greater MDLIVE Utilization




Jan – Aug, 2020 has seen a 109% increase in encounters compared to the same period in 2019

National: Mixed Impact on Costs

Increased Costs Decreased Costs COVID diagnosis/treatment Provider closures/mandated More complex/urgent care due to restrictions missed preventive care Fear keeps patients out of care Mental Health Limited travel to providers Prioritization of high-cost procedures Limited hospital capacity/staff Lower utilization due to economic Telemedicine in addition to, not instead of, in-person care uncertainty Some services are no longer needed



HealthFlex: Claims Impact Variable by Plan Sponsor

- Health care claims in Q2 2020 were lower than Q2 2019 for 20 of the 32 HealthFlex conferences
- However, 12 conferences still had increases in claims
